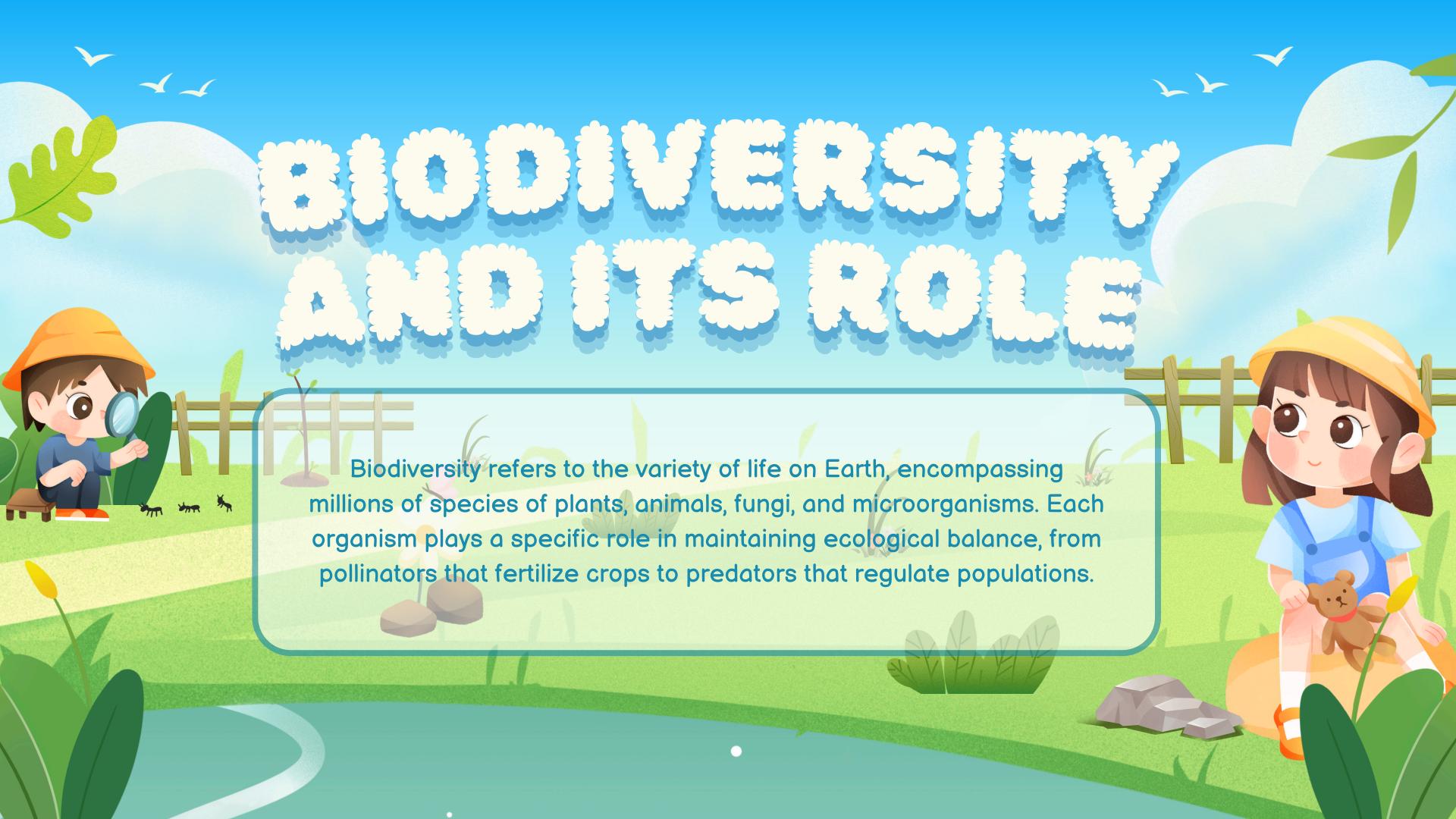


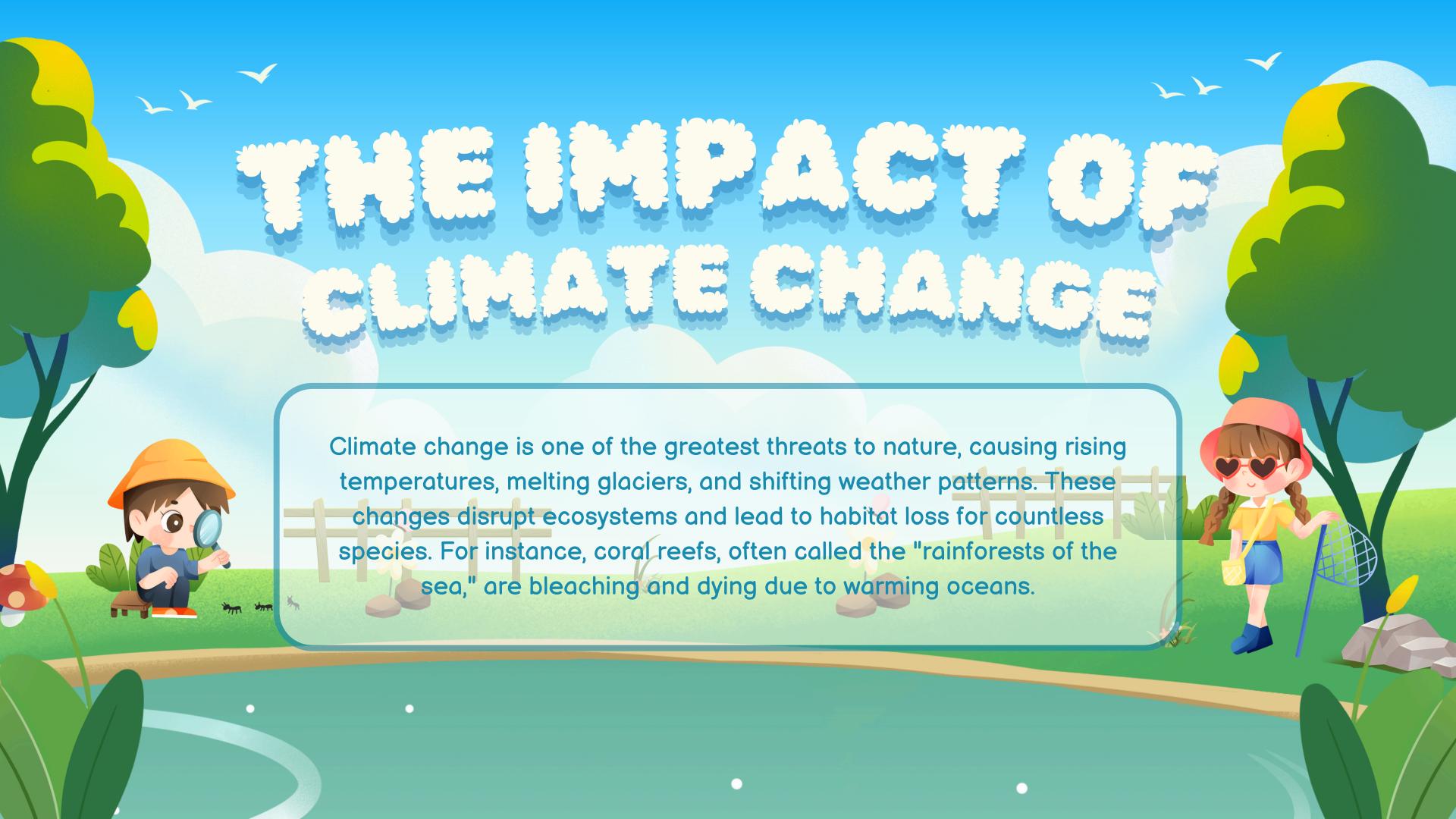
THE IMPORTANCE OF
